Professor Ilan Pappé was born in Haifa, Israel in 1954. He received his PhD from the University of Oxford, and was teaching in the department of the history of the modern Middle East in the University of Haifa between 1984 and 1994 and from 1994 to 2006 in the department of Political Science in the same university. From 2007 he is teaching in the University of Exeter, United Kingdom. He is a fellow of the Institute of Arab and Islamic Studies; a Director of the European Center for Palestine Studies and co-director of the Exeter Center for Ethno-Political Studies. His published works include: *The Ethnic Cleansing of Palestine* (London 2007); *A History of Modern Palestine* (Cambridge 2003) and *The Modern Middle East* (London 2012 Second Edition).
